You are about to purchase a product that is not simple and may be difficult to understand.

What is this product?

Type This product is qualified as a Packaged Retail Investors and Insurance Product ("PRIIP") and is a class of shares of the sub-fund Global Balanced Euro Feeder Fund (the "Sub-Fund") in the fund Ashburton Replica Portfolio Limited (the "Fund").

The Fund is a non-UCITS fund and is an open-ended investment company based in lersey. The Fund is a company which is registered with limited liability in accordance with the provisions of the Companies (Jersey) Law of 1991.


Objectives The investment objective of the Sub-Fund is to invest in the euro share class of the Ashburton Investments SICAV - Global Balanced Fund ("Global Balanced Fund"). The objective of the Global Balanced Fund is to provide investors with growth in capital plus an income over the medium term without exceeding a maximum equity exposure of 60%.

> The Sub-Fund should be viewed as a medium to long-term investment (Recommended Holding Period of at least 5 years). You can, however, withdraw your investment at any time.

Intended retail The product is suitable for medium to long term investment and for investor wanting to gain exposure to international equities, bonds, cash, money markets and some indirect exposure to non-traditional asset classes such as real estate, commodities, hedge funds or private equity.

Maturity date This product has no maturity date.

What are the risks and what could I get in return?



The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 5 years.

The actual risk can vary significantly if you cash in at an early stage and you may get back less.

The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because we are not able to pay you.

We have classified this product as 3 out of 7, which is a medium-low risk class. This rates the potential losses from future performance at a medium-low level, and poor market conditions are unlikely to impact the capacity to pay you.

Be aware of currency risk. You will receive payments in a different currency, so the final return you will get depends on the exchange rate between the two currencies. This risk is not considered in the indicator shown above.

The target fund of the Sub-Fund invests into equities, bonds money market instruments, cash, and some non-traditional assets such as real estate, commodities, hedge funds or private equity. This product is therefore subject to inherent markets

What are the costs?

The Reduction in Yield (RIY) shows what impact the total costs you pay will have on the investment return you might get. The total costs take into account one-off, ongoing and incidental costs.

The amounts shown here are the cumulative costs of the product itself, for three different holding periods. They include potential early exit penalties. The figures assume you invest EUR 10 000. The figures are estimates and may change in the future.

How long should I hold it and can I take my money out early?

Recommending Holding Period: 5 years

The Fund should be viewed as a medium to long-term investment (at least 5 years). You can, however, redeem your investment at any time by sending a redemption request to Ashburton (Jersey) Limited before 12 p.m. on any business day in Jersey to be dealt on the next dealing day.

It is, however, difficult to estimate how much you would get back if you cash in your investment before the end of the recommended holding period (at least 5 years).
