

The investment objective of the Sub-Fund is to maximise risk-adjusted returns over the long run while preserving capital, regardless of market conditions, by investing in companies whose primary source of income is from, or whose major assets are based on, the African continent. It is anticipated that at least 80% of the Fund will be invested in companies listed on African stock exchanges and the balance on stock exchanges outside Africa. The Fund can also invest up to 10% in selected investment opportunities, such as pre-IPO opportunities or unlisted investments.

This Fund is designed for investors wishing to participate in capital markets and may be most appropriate for investors with a medium to long term investment horizon, as losses may occur due to high market fluctuations.

Fund activity

- A rally in the US dollar accentuated weak equity markets almost across the continent. Following the Kenya Supreme Court's decision to annul the presidential election, this market led the decliners, with the market falling 5.8% in US dollar terms (although the currency was stable). Morocco (-3.3%) was the next largest contributor to the weakness, followed by Egypt (-3.0%) and Nigeria (-1.7%). Mauritius had another good month with gains of 2.8% in US dollar terms despite a 3.6% decline in the local currency.
- The Fund outperformed strongly in Egypt and Nigeria. The Fund's consumer shares in Egypt were the biggest contributor to the gains, notably MM Group (33.1%) and Obour Land (11.7%). In Nigeria, Seplat Petroleum's 9.5% gain was the main contributor. As with the index. Kenva was the major detractor from performance. The Fund's lack of exposure to Morocco also contributed to its outperformance in September.



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
