# GLOBAL GROWTH FUND (GBP HEDGED) R SHARE CLASS



The primary aim is to maximise total return (capital plus income) over the long term, through a flexible asset allocation across a diversified range of asset classes, regions and currencies without exceeding a maximum equity exposure of 75%


The Sub-Fund is designed as a moderate to higher risk strategy for clients who are prepared to take an increased level of risk with their capital.

- Equity markets recovered from fears of fully fledged global trade war as the political ramifications of higher tariffs point to some pragmatism around the issue.
- Most Emerging Market (EM) currencies and rates have recovered from worst levels, with the exception of Turkey where the US ramped up rhetoric around possible sanctions, and China, where the renminbi weakened a further 3%, bringing total move since mid-June to 6.5%.
- Commodity prices continued to fall, with the Commodity Research Bureau (CRB) Raw Industrials index down another 0.7% in the month, as shifts in global supply chains began to hit home.
- The CRB Raw Industrials index fell from its highest levels in the year to its lowest levels in the space of 2 weeks. Given the increasing signs of economic stresses, we maintained a slightly defensive positioning, continuing to
- shift away from EM debt exposure into Developed Markets (DM) sovereign, specifically cutting Mexico exposure after election results there.
