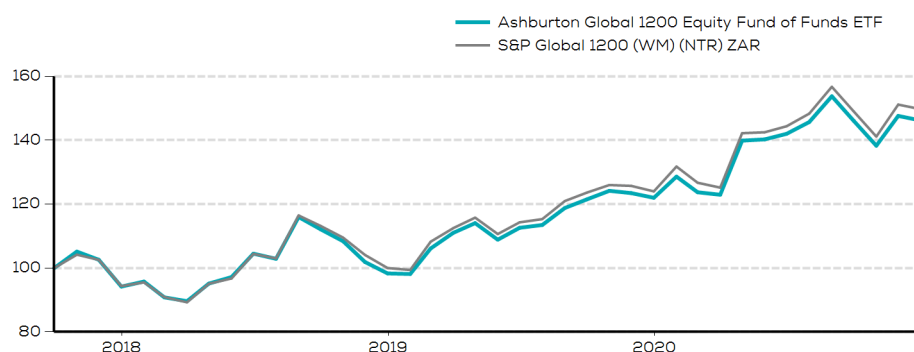
Investor profile

The Ashburton Global 1200 Equity Fund of Funds ETF is suitable for investors seeking a cost efficient, convenient investment with exposure to international equities across developed and emerging markets. The fund offers quarterly distributions with no prescribed fixed investment period. The fund can also act as a building block for investors to use when constructing their own portfolios.

Investment objectives and strategy

The Ashburton Global 1200 Equity Fund of Funds ETF provides investors with efficient exposure to the global equity market by tracking the S&P Global 1200. The S&P Global 1200 Index captures 70% of the world's market capitalisation, covering seven distinct regions and 30 countries. The ETF is structured as a Fund of Funds ETF and achieves efficient tracking by investing in underlying ETFs that track the seven composite headline indices comprising the S&P Global 1200 Index. The fund holds ETFs tracking the S&P500 (US), MSCI Europe, S&P TOPIX 150 (Japan), S&P/TSX 60 (Canada), S&P/ASX All Australian 50, S&P Asia 50 and S&P Latin America 40. Each stock in the index must meet liquidity standards and each component region has appropriate sector representation. The size of each region corresponds to its relative size in the global equity market, based on a float-adjusted market value.

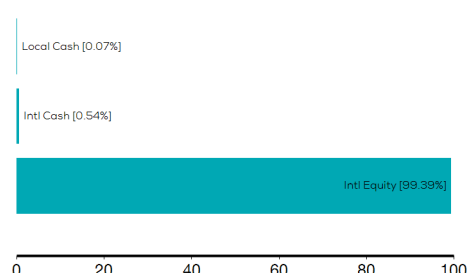

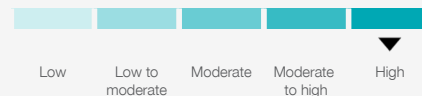

Definitions

Total return:	Total return accounts for two categories of return: income and capital appreciation. Income includes interest paid by fixed income investments, distributions or dividends. Capital appreciation represents the change in the market price of an asset.
NAV (net asset value):	This is the total value of assets in the portfolio less any liabilities, divided by the number of shares outstanding.
TER (total expense ratio):	This is a measure of the total costs associated with managing and operating an investment fund. These costs consist primarily of management fees and additional expenses such as trustee and custody fees, auditor fees and other operational expenses. The total cost of the fund is divided by the fund's total assets to arrive at a percentage, which represents the TER.
Index:	In the case of financial markets, an index is a theoretical portfolio of assets representing a particular market or a portion of it. Each index has its own calculation methodology and is usually expressed in terms of a change from a base value. Thus, the percentage change is more important than the actual numeric value.
Transaction costs:	Total costs incurred by the investor in buying and selling the underlying assets of a financial product and is expressed as a percentage of the daily NAV calculated on an annualised basis. These costs include brokerage, VAT, and trading costs.
Annualised cost:	Is the cost per year of investing in the assets of a financial product.
Annualised return:	This is the average rate earned by the investment over a year in the period measured.
Tracking error:	A measure of the amount of risk that is being taken in excess of the benchmark.
